

## Welcome from the LOA President

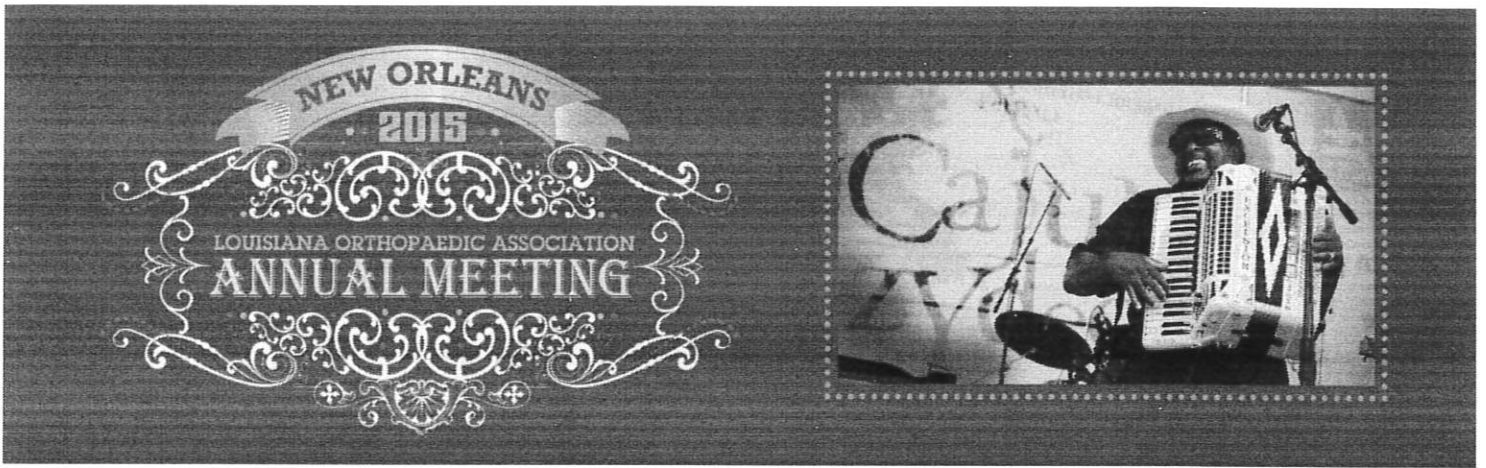

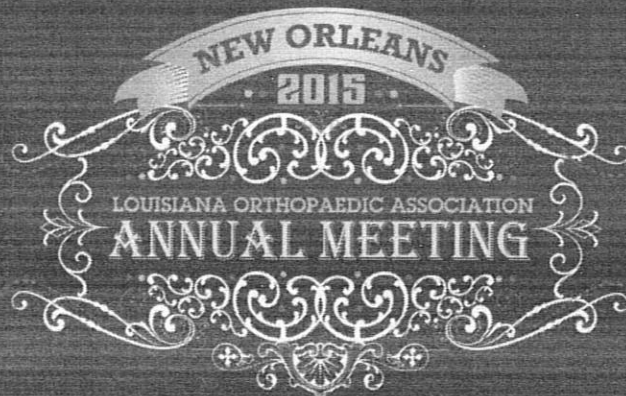
