Adam trained internationally and is published on stem cell biology and cell therapy. Dr. Anz will educate us on the most up to date concepts and procedures using cell therapy to treat our patients.

Dr. Benton Emblom is a Sports Medicine Specialist at the Andrews Institute in Birmingham, Alabama. Dr. Emblom was a previous Andrew's Sports Fellow and then completed additional training in arthroscopic and mini-open hip surgery. Dr. Emblom has special interest in the treatment of Core Muscle injuries, or Sports Hernias, and will update us on his methods of their diagnosis and management.
